

Bumper Removal.

- 1. Remove rear light clusters by removing the black inner plastic trim to reveal two fixings per light cluster.
- 2. Remove three fixings from each wheel arch, peel back wheel arch liner to reveal one tip fixing either side. Remove six fixings along bumper lower edge.
- 3. Carefully release the bumper from the vehicle body and pull rearwards disconnecting any necessary wiring looms.
- 4. Remove the rear impact beam (this is not refitted with the Towbar assembly). Replace fixings into rear panel to prevent water ingress.
- 5. As per Fig 3 Use Item N with Items P to prevent water ingress. As per Fig 2 cut the heat shield, NOTE: Some models are pre-cut.

Towbar Installation.

- 1. Insert Items B into each correct chassis member and fix through the rearmost mounting point using Item F with Item J, fix at the forward mounting point using Item E with Item J.
- 2. Fix Item A between each side arm using Items F with Items K.
- 3. Fix Item C to Item A using Items H with Items K and Item G with Items K ensuring Item L is fitted between the lowest mounting point.
- **4.** Fully tighten all fixings ensuring the Towbar is rigid, square and secure.
- 5. Cut the rear bumper as per Fig:1 Relocating the boot sensor cable when applicable and refit. NOTE: Some models are pre-cut.
- 6. Using Item D fix your desired ball bracket and wiring plate (Not supplied in this kit) to Item C and fully tighten.



Notes:

- **1.** For Torque settings see general notes overleaf.
- 2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
