

Tow-Trust Towbars



Bumper Removal:

- 1. Open tailgate and remove light clusters, one fixing behind boot trim panel each side.
- 2. Remove the three fixings from the wheel arch liner and mudguards if fitted and the tip screw from each side.
- **3.** Remove the nine fixings from the lower bumper edge.
- 4. Pull bumper out sideways and release clips from under the light clusters pull rearwards, unplug the reversing sensors and number plate lights and fully remove. Note: (Volkswagen T-Cross requires a new lower bumper panel, Part Number 2GM 807 521B)
- **5.** Remove item **X**, one fixing from off the rear crash beam if fitted, then remove the crash beam, seven fixings. Note: (This will not be refitted with the towbar assembly). Refit the fixings into the rear panel to prevent water ingress.
- **6.** Separate the charcoal cannister from the offside chassis to gain access to the mounting point, two fixings.

Towbar Installation:

- 1. Loosely fix items **B1** and **B2** to the correct chassis rail using items **J** with items **N** on the correct setting for the vehicle. (Figure 1)
- 2. Loosely fix item A to items B1 and B2 (with item C on Skoda Kamiq in between) using items K with items M.
- 3. Fully tighten all the fixings ensuring the Towbar is rigid, square and secure.
- 4. If applicable remount item X to item A using items H and items L.
- 5. Remount the charcoal canister and rear bumper. Note: (Some models may require pre-marked cut to be removed from bumper).
- 6. Loosely fix item D to item A with items T1 on the correct setting (Figure 2) using items G and items M.
- 7. Using items F secure your desired ball bracket and wiring plate (Not supplied in this kit) to item D.
- 8. Fully tighten all remaining fixings.



Notes:

- 1. For Torque settings see general notes overleaf.
- 2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturer's trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
- 3. We recommend the use of PRO-TOW Couplings with all our products.
